## **Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Policy Statement (WEEE)**

The WEEE Directive (Directive 2012/19/EU) on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) placed obligations upon users and producers to handle their electronic and electrical waste more carefully. Such waste cannot be placed in landfill. In the UK the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 (SI2013/3113) applies to all businesses that import, manufacture or re-brand electrical and electronic equipment. They are also relevant to businesses that dispose of WEEE.

All businesses producing EEE must have joined a Compliance Scheme – Holroyd Components Ltd has joined Wastecare (<https://www.wastecare.co.uk>)

In order to comply with regulations, Holroyd Components Ltd provides two options to our customers for when our products eventually become waste:

The customer can choose to appropriately dispose of the waste, via their chosen contractor.

The customer can choose to contact Holroyd Components Ltd to arrange for unwanted product to be collected. We will then arrange for our Compliance Scheme Operator to take the waste. We do however reserve the right to make a charge at that time as we did not charge at the time the Holroyd Components Ltd parts were purchased.
